

# THE FOUR YEAR PLAN

You asked, we created! If you're in a traditional high school setting, you may want to spread *Equipped for Life Academy* out over four years. The Four Year Plan makes *EFLA* less time consuming for individual teachers to implement, and it enables you to save more philosophically challenging material for the older grades. It also helps students retain the information and cultivate a deeper understanding of the importance of pro-life issues, as they will engage with the issue of abortion every year in this model.

While you are always welcome to mix and match lessons to create your own plan for teaching *EFLA*, here is our recommendation for spreading the curriculum over four years.
